

Load and Secure Cargo Skill Set

Course Outcomes

SpanSet Australia's *Load and Secure Cargo* short course develops the skills and knowledge to load and unload goods and cargo, secure and protect a load, lash and unlash cargo, protect cargo from weather, pack and unpack cargo, understand the Australian Dangerous Goods Code, International Maritime Dangerous Goods markings and the national Transport Commission's Load Restraint Guide, and complete all required documentation in accordance with relevant roads and traffic authority regulations and permit requirements.

Who this course is for

Entry Requirements

Students should have a good level of the English language to be able to appropriately communicate on a worksite, be able to read, interpret and apply safety signs, adjust work methods in response to changing weather and site conditions and identify (and set controls for) workplace hazards.

A preliminary assessment for these entry requirements is necessary.

 - sort, stack, secure, check, protect and inspect a load, and
 - use lashing and lifting equipment.

Training Outcome

All successful students will receive a Statement of Attainment for the following units of competency:

and
TLIA1001 Secure cargo.
