Course Outcomes

SpanSet Australia's PUASAR022 *Participate in a rescue operation* course develops the skills and knowledge required to participate in rescue operations as a member of a rescue team.

This course focuses on SpanSet Australia's Gotcha Rescue Kit; a pre-assembled rescue system designed for either remote lifting or lowering of a casualty for rescue. The kit can be used for recovery of a casualty suspended on fall arrest equipment without the need to cut them free or put the rescuer at risk.

Duration

2 Days

Entry Requirements

For those students obtaining a full fire sector qualification, the prerequisite unit of HLTAID011 *Provide First Aid* must be obtained PRIOR to this course.

Students should have a good level of the English language to be able to appropriately communicate on a worksite, read safety signs, adjust work methods in response to changing weather and site conditions and identify (and set controls for) workplace hazards. A preliminary assessment for these entry requirements is necessary.

Due to the physical performance requirements of this course, all participants are expected to have a reasonable level of mental and physical fitness. Please contact us if you have any concerns regarding your capabilities.

Assessment

- prepare for a rescue operation,

- perform a vertical rescue using communication methods, techniques and appropriate terminology
- prepare casualties for safe removal using appropriate equipment, rescue techniques and procedures, and
- conclude rescue operations, including participation in an operational debriefing.

Training Outcome

All successful students will receive a Statement of Attainment for PUASAR022 *Participate in a rescue operation*.
