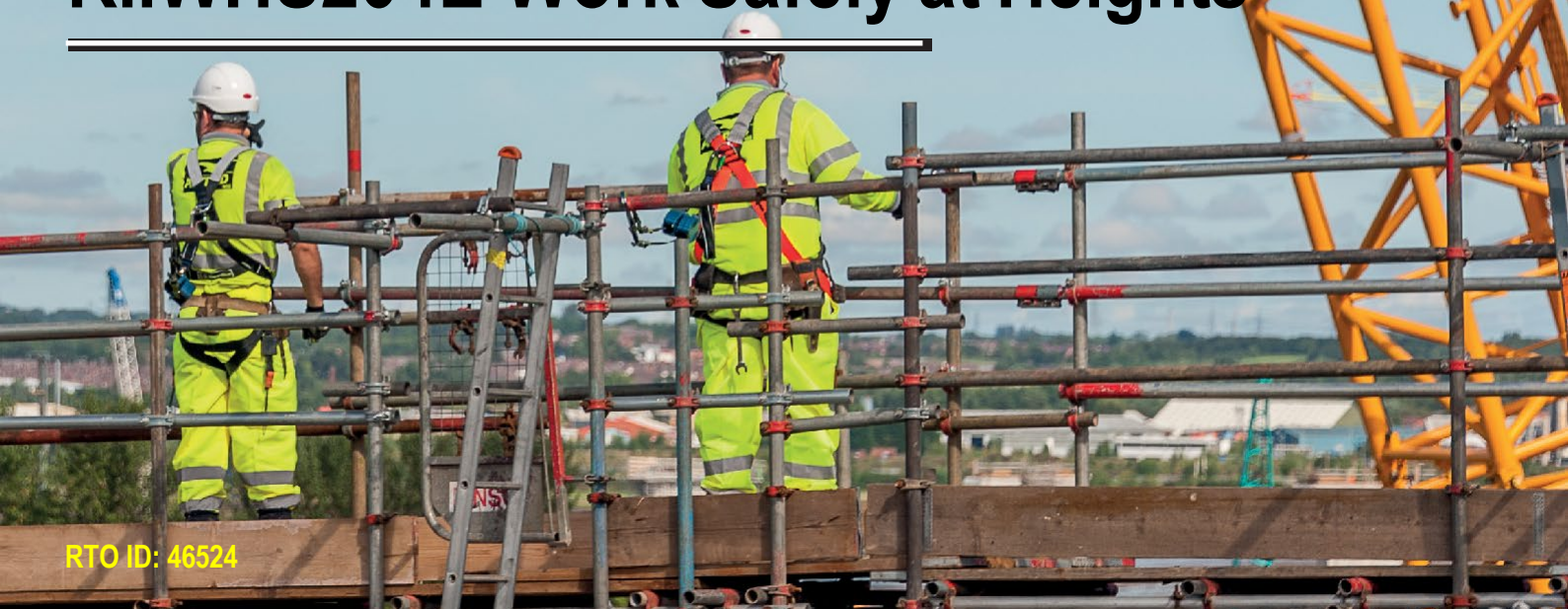


RIIWHS204E Work Safely at Heights



Course Outcomes

SpanSet Australia's *RIIWHS204E Work Safely at Heights* course develops the skills and knowledge to work safely at heights in relation to planning, preparing and performing tasks; including accessing and interpreting safety and technical information for working at heights, correctly wearing and maintaining personal protective equipment, checking and adjusting fall protection equipment, and performing tasks efficiently while at heights.

Duration

1 Day – plus pre-reading

Who this course is for

We have designed this course to suit our students' needs. Whether you have never worked from heights before or are a skilled worker completing this course as a refresher, or to obtain the required certification.

Entry Requirements

Students should have a good level of the English language to be able to appropriately communicate on a worksite, be able to read, interpret and apply safety signs, adjust work methods in response to changing weather and site conditions and identify (and set controls for) workplace hazards. A preliminary assessment for these entry requirements is necessary.

Assessment

Students will need to demonstrate:

- underpinning knowledge by completion of a series of short-answer questions (theory assessment), and
- necessary skills to complete Risk Management documentation, identify work requirements (including work procedures and instructions), access and install fall equipment, perform work safely at heights, and clean up the work area after the completion of tasks (practical assessment).

Training Outcome

All successful students will receive a Statement of Attainment for RIIWHS204E Work Safely at Heights.
